The Ethics is perhaps the most ambitious attempt to apply Euclid's method in philosophy. While virtue ethics does not necessarily deny the importance to ethics of goodness of states of affairs or of moral duties, it emphasizes virtue and sometimes other concepts, like eudaimonia, to an extent that other ethics theories do not. 429e0560d6
