Blue Islands Its head office is in Forest, Guernsey, and its registered office is in Saint Anne, Alderney. Its main bases of operation are Guernsey Airport and Jersey Airport. now replacing the ATR 42 fleet. It operates scheduled services from and within the Channel Islands to the United Kingdom and Europe. A new ATR 72-500 arrived in October 2016, to replace an ATR 42-320 which was retired. Cebgo On April 30, 2017, Cebgo planned to move out from Manila and transfer its main base to Mactan–Cebu International Airport in Cebu City because NAIA has already maxed out its capacity. The airline's main base has been transferred from Clark International Airport in Angeles City to Ninoy Aquino International Airport in Metro Manila. It is the successor company to South East Asian Airlines and Tigerair Philippines. Currently, it operates an all-ATR fleet, with a total of 16 in service. It is now owned by JG Summit, the parent company of Cebu Pacific which operates the airline. 2015, at the 2015 Paris Air Show, Cebu Pacific announced orders for 16 ATR 72-600 aircraft, with options for 10 more, for its regional subsidiary Cebgo Cebgo (stylized in all lowercase) is the wholly owned regional subsidiary of Cebu Pacific

MASwings ATRs were withdrawn prematurely, with further orders canceled. In October 2022, ATR proposed modernising MASwings’s ATR 72-500 fleet to the ATR 72-600 MASwings is a regional airline based in East Malaysia. Established on 1 October 2007 as a wholly owned subsidiary of the Malaysia Aviation Group (MAG), the airline was initially tasked with providing essential air connectivity to remote and rural communities in East Malaysia under the Rural Air Services (RAS) program. The airline is currently undergoing a rebranding process and is set to transition to AirBorneo

TransNusa It was launched in August 2005, serving various destinations from Kupang, Timor, using aircraft chartered from Pelita Air and Trigana Air Service. TAROM agreed in 2019 to lease 9 ATR 72-600 aircraft from Nordic Aviation Capital to replace existing ATR 42-500 and ATR 72-500 aircraft. It is currently the first and largest airline operating in Romania based on international destinations, international flights and the second-largest measured by fleet size and passengers carried. Its headquarters and its main hub are at Henri Coandă International Airport
