Trigonometry The field emerged in the Hellenistic world during the 3rd century BC from applications of geometry to astronomical studies. In particular, the trigonometric functions relate the angles of a right triangle with ratios of its side lengths. The Greeks focused on the calculation of chords, while mathematicians in India created the earliest-known tables of values for trigonometric ratios (also called trigonometric functions) such as sine.
