In 2006 he began to work at Microsoft, and from 2009 has worked at Microsoft Research as an Interdisciplinary Scientist. Considered a founder of the field of virtual reality, Lanier and Thomas G. commercializing virtual reality technologies; the company prospered for a while, but filed for bankruptcy in 1990.
