Halting problem For any specific program and input, one of these two algorithms answers correctly In computability theory, the halting problem is the problem of determining, from a description of an arbitrary computer program and an input,

whether the program will finish running, or continue to run forever. always answers "halts" and another that always answers "does not halt". The problem comes up often in discussions of computability since it demonstrates that some functions are mathematically definable but not computable. The halting problem is undecidable, meaning that no general algorithm exists that solves the halting problem for all possible program-input pairs

and 22) at the Paris conference of the International Hilbert's problems are 23 problems in mathematics published by German mathematician David Hilbert in 1900. They were all unsolved at the time, and several proved to be very influential for 20th-century mathematics. Hilbert presented ten of the problems (1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 13, 16, 19, 21, and 22) at the Paris conference of the International Congress of Mathematicians, speaking on August 8 at the Sorbonne. Earlier publications (in the original German) appeared in Archiv der Mathematik und Physik. The complete list of 23 problems was published later, in English translation in 1902 by Mary Frances Winston Newson in the Bulletin of the American Mathematical Society 0661db4bc2
