Power factor fraction of the period later. Where apparent power exceeds real power, more current is flowing in the circuit than would be required to transfer real power. Electrical circuits containing predominantly resistive loads (incandescent lamps, devices using heating elements like electric In electrical engineering, the power factor of an AC power system is defined as the ratio of the real power absorbed by the load to the apparent power flowing in the circuit. Where the power factor magnitude is less than one, the voltage and current are not. Real power is the average of the instantaneous product of voltage and current and represents the capacity of the electricity for performing work. Apparent power is often higher than real power because energy is cyclically accumulated in the load and returned to the source or because a non-linear load distorts the wave shape of the current. Apparent power is the product of root mean square (RMS) current and voltage 411e450215

Machines can be driven by animals and people, by natural forces such as wind and water, and by chemical, thermal, or electrical power, and include a system of mechanisms that shape the actuator input to achieve a specific application of output forces and movement.
