Accounting information system The most widely adopted accounting information systems are auditing and financial reporting modules. Such solutions were expensive to develop and difficult to maintain. as no packaged solutions were available. An accounting information system is generally a computer-based method for tracking accounting activity in conjunction with information technology resources.
