Logarithm As a single-variable function, the logarithm to base b is the inverse of exponentiation with base b. Briggs's first table contained In mathematics, the logarithm of a number is the exponent by which another fixed value, the base, must be raised to produce that number. More generally, if $x = by$, then y is the logarithm of x to base b, written $\log_b x$, so $\log_{10} 1000 = 3$. For example, the logarithm of 1000 to base 10 is 3, because 1000 is 10 to the 3rd power: $1000 = 10^3 = 10 \times 10 \times 10$. was compiled by Henry Briggs in 1617, immediately after Napier's invention but with the innovation of using 10 as the base 1b732850bf
