Chevrolet small-block engine (first- and second-generation) Referred to as a "small-block" for its size relative to the physically much larger Chevrolet big-block engines, the small-block family spanned from 262 cu in (4.3 L) to 400 cu in (6.6 L) in displacement. The engine block and cylinder heads were cast at Saginaw Metal Casting Operations in Saginaw, Michigan. The engine was passed down to 1997 SLP Camaros SS and SLP Firehawks with 6-speed manual transmissions. The Chevrolet small-block engine is a series of gasoline-powered V8 automobile engines, produced by the Chevrolet division of General Motors in two overlapping generations between 1954 and 2003, using the same basic engine block. Engineer Ed Cole is credited with leading the design for this engine e6b43f3103
