Cooper's hawk It is easily confused with the smaller but similar sharp-shinned hawk. The birds found east of the Mississippi River tend to be larger on average than the birds found to the west. sufficiently forceful enough to drive away more formidable predators such as bobcats (*Lynx rufus*) from the nest area. (*Accipiter striatus*). As in many birds of prey, the male is smaller than the female. When large quadrupeds walk under the nest Cooper's hawk (*Astur cooperii*) is a medium-sized hawk native to the North American continent and found from southern Canada to Mexico.
