The WISC-V takes 45 to 65 minutes to administer. It generates a Full Scale IQ (formerly known as an intelligence quotient or IQ score) that represents a child's general intellectual ability. It also provides five primary index scores, namely Verbal Comprehension Index, Visual Spatial Index, Fluid Reasoning Index, Working Memory Index, and Processing Speed Index. These indices represent a child's abilities in discrete cognitive domains. Five ancillary composite scores can be derived from various combinations of primary or primary and secondary subtests. In the UK, the UCAT was one of two main admissions tests used for medical, dental and other health-related courses, the other being the BioMedical Admissions Test (BMAT). Following the BMAT's cancellation from 2024 onwards, all ex-BMAT universities have moved to using the UCAT for their undergraduate medical courses, including Oxford and Cambridge.

California Basic Educational Skills Test Test-takers do not have to pass all three sections in one sitting. A \$41 registration fee for paper-based testing (\$30 for each of the three sections in the computer-based testing) must. It is available as an option in Oregon and Nevada. The entire test must be completed in four hours, and test-takers may allocate the time to each section at their discretion. There is no limit to the number of times the test may be taken. It does not test an individual's teaching skills or abilities; it only tests reading skills (critical analysis, evaluation, comprehension, and research The California Basic Educational Skills Test (CBEST) is a standardized test administered in the state of California. Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test Apart from the English language reading comprehension test, all sections are taken in Swedish. 0 The Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test (SweSAT)(Swedish: högskoleprovet) is a standardised test used as one of the means to gain admission to higher education in Sweden. All sections are taken in one day, a Saturday in April (Spring test) or a Sunday in October (Autumn test), lasting between 7½ and 8 hours including breaks between each section and a lunch break. The result on the test is normalised to a scale between 0. The test itself, which is administered by the Swedish Council for Higher Education, is divided into a mathematical part and a verbal part, which both respectively contain 4 subdivisions, in total 160 multiple-choice questions. A standardized test is administered and scored uniformly for all test takers.
