In the classical period of Indian mathematics (400 CE to 1200 CE), important contributions were made by scholars like Aryabhata, Brahmagupta, Bhaskara II, Varāhamihira, and Madhava

The ancient Romans The history of mathematics deals with the origin of discoveries in mathematics and the mathematical methods and notation of the past. (especially through the introduction of deductive reasoning and mathematical rigor in proofs) and expanded the subject matter of mathematics. From 3000 BC the Mesopotamian states of Sumer, Akkad and Assyria, followed closely by Ancient Egypt and the Levantine state of Ebla began using arithmetic, algebra and geometry for taxation, commerce, trade, and in astronomy, to record time and formulate calendars dc39b69dc8

Mathematics education in the United States Some Mathematics education in the United States varies considerably from one state to the next, and even within a single state. The SAT, a standardized university entrance exam, has been reformed to better reflect the contents of the Common Core. With the adoption of the Common Core Standards in most states and the District of Columbia beginning in 2010, mathematics content across the country has moved into closer agreement for each grade level. Notation generally implies a set of well-defined representations of quantities and symbols operators. Mathematical notation comprises the symbols used to write mathematical equations and formulas

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
