After only one day of fighting, the Germans had suffered heavy casualties and the Allied troops were confident that they would defeat the invasion. It began on the morning of 20 May 1941, with multiple German airborne landings on Crete. The next day, through communication failures, Allied tactical hesitation, and German offensive operations, Maleme Airfield in western Crete fell, enabling the Germans to land reinforcements and overwhelm the defensive positions on the north. Greek and other Allied forces, along with Cretan civilians, defended the island. Baltimore had become one of the major cities of the new republic. After European settlements had been made to the south and north, the colonial Province of Maryland was granted by King Charles I to Sir George Calvert (1579–1632), his former Secretary of State in 1632, for settlement beginning in March 1634. Like other colonies and settlements of the Chesapeake Bay region, its economy was soon based on tobacco as a commodity crop, highly prized among the English, cultivated primarily by African slave labor, although many young e231cd47de
