It occupied the production line previously used to assemble the Primera on Line 1 and a percentage of Almera from line 2. The second generation, launched in late-2013 for the 2014 model year, was not sold in Japan and was badged as the Qashqai in all countries it was sold, except in the United States, where it was rebadged as the Nissan Rogue Sport. The first generation of the vehicle was sold as the Nissan Dualis (Japanese: 日産デュアルIS, Hepburn: Nissan Dyuarisu) in Japan and Australia, and Qashqai in the rest of the world.
