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Primary texts of Kabbalah probably incorporating some pre-existing traditions. Cassiel Sefer Raziel lists Cassiel as the prince of Saturn. The Zohar describes Cassiel as Cassiel (Hebrew: קַצְפִּיֵּאל Qaṣṣpī'ēl, "God is my wrath")—also known as Kassiel, Qassiel, and other phonetic variations—is an angel appearing in extracanonical Jewish, Christian, and Islamic mystical and magical works, often as one of the Seven Archangels, the angel of Saturn, and in other roles. also listed in Ma'aseh Merkavah as a guardian of the second palace 84469ca336

He is also known as Caftsiel and Captsiel (Hebrew: קַצְפִּיֵּאל Qaṣṣpī'ēl, "God is my leap"; Arabic: كسفيايل, Kasfīyā'īl), among other phonetic translations and variations. 84469ca336

Manda d-Hayyi Raziel is mentioned in Kabbalistic texts such as Sefer Raziel HaMalakh. Both are described In Mandaism, Manda d-Hayyi or Manda d-Hiia (Classical Mandaic: ܡܢܕܐ ܕܗܝܝܝ ܡܢܕܐ ܕܗܝܝܐ, lit. also be compared to the angel Raziel in the Jewish tradition. 'the 'Gnosis of Life', 'Knowledge of Life', or 'Knower of the Life', Modern Mandaic pronunciation: ['mendatʰ 'hejji] (mandā-ṭ-heyyi) is an uthra (angel or guardian) sent by the Great Life (Hayyi Rabbi, or the Transcendent God) as a messenger to John the Baptist. Manda d-Hayyi is considered to be the most important uthra, since he is the one bringing manda (knowledge or gnosis) to Earth (Tibil) 84469ca336

Raziel In Jewish mysticism, Raziel delivers the "Sefer Raziel" to Adam, containing esoteric secrets about the universe and Raziel, (Hebrew: רַזִּיָּאֵל Rāzī'ēl, "God is my Mystery") also known as Gallitsur (Hebrew: גַּלִּיטוּר Gallitūr) is an angel within the teachings of Jewish mysticism (of the Kabbalah of Judaism) who is the "Angel of Secrets" and the "Angel of Mysteries". " He is one of the angels associated with the sephirah Chokmah of Kabbalah, alongside Jophiel. He is also called "Keeper of All Magic. knowledge to humans, especially Adam 84469ca336

"Book of Secrets") is a Jewish magical text supposedly given to Noah by the angel Raziel, and passed down throughout Sefer HaRazim (Hebrew: ספר הרזים; "Book of Secrets") is a Jewish magical text supposedly given to Noah by the angel Raziel, and passed down throughout Biblical history until it ended up in the possession of Solomon, for whom it was a great source of his wisdom and purported magical powers. This is not the same work as the Sefer Raziel HaMalakh, which was given to Adam by the same angel, although both works stem from the same tradition, and large parts of Sefer HaRazim were incorporated into the Sefer Raziel under its original title

In Mandaism, after the creation... It receives its name from Numbers 11:16: "Gather unto me ["Esfah-li"] seventy men of the elders of Israel." In Yalkut Shimoni §736 a citation relating to this verse appears, which cannot be traced to any other midrash and is undoubtedly taken from Midrash Esfah.

Midrash Esfah known only from a few excerpts in Yalkut Shimoni and two citations in Sefer Raziel and Ha-Roḳeah. It receives its name from Numbers 11:16: "Gather unto Midrash Esfah (Hebrew: מדרש אספה) is one of the smaller midrashim, which as yet is known only from a few excerpts in Yalkut Shimoni and two citations in Sefer Raziel and Ha-Roḳeah.

The angel Raziel can be compared to the Manda d-Hayyi of

Mandaism. Both are described as intermediaries who convey divine knowledge to humans, especially Adam. In Jewish mysticism, Raziel delivers the "Sefer Raziel" to Adam, containing esoteric secrets about the universe and divine mysteries, while in Mandaism, Manda d-Hayyi instructs Adam about the mysteries of life and creation. 84469ca336

Sachiel The Sefer Raziel is highly inconsistent in its spelling of In kabbalistic and Christian angelology, Sachiel (Ge'ez ሰጂዒል) is an archangel of the order of cherubim. from the early-1200s Jewish occult book Sefer Raziel HaMalakh ('book of Raziel the angel'). The name 'Sachiel' originally occurs in the late 1500s grimoire called The Heptameron 84469ca336

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
