Teachers in an ESL class are specifically trained in particular techniques and tools to help students learn English as a second or foreign language refers to the use of English by individuals whose native language is different, commonly among students learning to speak and write English. Programs such as ESL are designed as academic courses to instruct non-native speakers in English proficiency, encompassing both learning in English-speaking nations and abroad. learning abilities and academic performance

The major work of Kenneth Pike on the subject is Phonemics: a technique for reducing languages to writing. Structured word inquiry (2010), found that teaching morphology helps students connect spelling, meaning, and pronunciation in ways that enhance reading and writing. The guiding principles of SWI are (1) "the primary function of English spelling is to represent meaning" and (2) "conventions by which English spelling represents meaning are so well-ordered and reliable that spelling can be investigated and understood through scientific inquiry. ". SWI emphasizes the scientific exploration of word structure through morphology, etymology, related words, and phonology.
