A study in 2019 showed that around 92% of trading in the Forex market was performed by trading algorithms rather than humans.

Foreign exchange market and are traded more than to most other futures contracts. Most developed countries permit the trading of derivative products (such as futures and options). The foreign exchange market (forex, FX, or currency market) is a global decentralized or over-the-counter (OTC) market for the trading of currencies. Hedgers, who engage in transactions to offset some other pre-existing... The main participants are the larger international banks. Financial centres function as anchors of trading between a range of multiple types of buyers and sellers around the clock, with the exception of weekends. As currencies are always traded in pairs, the market does not set a currency's absolute value, but rather determines its relative value by setting the market price of one currency if paid for with another.
