Enrico Fermi He has been called the "architect of the nuclear age" and the "architect of the atomic bomb". He was one of very few physicists to excel in both theoretical and experimental physics. He made significant contributions to the development. During this time Fermi learned tensor calculus, a technique key to general relativity. With his colleagues, Fermi filed several patents related to the use of nuclear power, all of which were taken over by the US government. Fermi initially chose mathematics as his major but soon switched to Enrico Fermi (Italian: [en'ri:ko 'fermi]; 29 September 1901 – 28 November 1954) was an Italian and naturalized American physicist, renowned for being the creator of the world's first artificial nuclear reactor, the Chicago Pile-1, and a member of the Manhattan Project. Fermi was awarded the 1938 Nobel Prize in Physics for his work on induced radioactivity by neutron bombardment and for the discovery of transuranium elements 2a67c57019

Related results provide more refined statements about how close the approximation is.
