Without testing facilities available locally, samples were initially sent to be tested in the UK The COVID-19 pandemic in the Bailiwick of Guernsey was a part of the worldwide pandemic of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). The Bailiwick has been successful in limiting and preventing the spread of the virus through a rigorous system of testing, tracing and isolating suspected and confirmed cases and requiring arrivals to self-isolate for 14 (or in some cases only 7) days. The States of Guernsey co-ordinates the pandemic response which has been praised for its transparency and clarity and held up as an exemplar of good communication
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Cantonese largely because of phonological differences, but also differences in grammar and vocabulary. It originated in the city of Guangzhou (formerly romanised as Canton) and its surrounding Pearl River Delta.
