When exposed to moist air, it forms oxides and hydrides that can expand the sample up to 70% in volume, which in turn flake off as a powder that is pyrophoric. The element normally exhibits six allotropes and four oxidation states. It reacts with carbon, halogens, nitrogen, silicon, and hydrogen. 7 years and Plutonium is a chemical element; it has symbol Pu and atomic number 94. It is radioactive and can accumulate in bones, which makes the handling of plutonium dangerous. and the percentage of plutonium-240 determines its grade (weapons-grade, fuel-grade, or reactor-grade).
