Bell Labs. Archived from Research Unix refers to the early versions of the Unix operating system for DEC PDP-7, PDP-11, VAX and Interdata 7/32 and 8/32 computers, developed in the Bell Labs Computing Sciences Research Center (CSRC). However, that term was little-used until Version 8 Unix (1985), but has been retroactively applied to earlier versions as well.
