Yield (engineering) Russell; Dewolf, John T. Professional. Once the yield point is passed, some fraction of the deformation will be permanent and non-reversible and is known as plastic deformation. In materials science and engineering, the yield point is the point on a stress-strain curve that indicates the limit of elastic behavior and the beginning of plastic behavior.
