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Phonics Phonics is a method for teaching reading and writing to beginners. It can be used with any writing system that is alphabetic, such as that of English, Russian, and most other languages. Phonics is also sometimes used as part of the process of teaching Chinese people (and foreign students) to read and write Chinese characters, which are not alphabetic, using pinyin, which is alphabetic. Kindergarten Such institutions were originally made in the late 18th century in Germany and Alsace to serve children whose parents both worked outside home. Today, the term is used in many countries to describe a variety of educational institutions and learning spaces for children ranging from two to six years of age, based on a variety of teaching methods. In 1779, Johann Friedrich Oberlin and Louise Scheppler founded in Strasbourg an early establishment for caring for and educating children. Kindergarten is a preschool educational approach based on playing, singing, practical activities such as drawing, and social interaction as part of the transition from home to school. variety of teaching methods. The term was coined by German pedagogue Friedrich Fröbel, whose approach globally influenced early-years education

History of education The earliest known formal school was developed in Egypt's Middle Kingdom under the direction of Khety,
