Commercially, the single topped the charts of Australia, Ireland, and New Zealand and reached number two on the UK singles chart, number three on the US Billboard Hot 100 (becoming their first top-40 hit), and number five on the Canadian RPM 100 Singles chart. Its accompanying music video was directed by Adam Bernstein and won an award at the 1990 MTV Video Music Awards. The song was later named one of the 365 Songs of the Century by the Recording Industry Association of America and one of the 500 Greatest Songs of All Time by Rolling Stone. The album was Houston's first non-holiday project since Just Whitney (2002). It received generally favorable reviews, with critics praising Houston's emotional, more mature vocals and the album's themes of resilience and

recovery, though many noted that it did not fully match the vocal power or impact of her classic work.
