It first appeared on Version 7 Unix, as its default shell. Unix-like systems continue to have /bin/sh—which will be the Bourne shell, or a symbolic link or hard link to a compatible shell—even when other shells are used by most users

A CLI enables automating programs since commands can be stored in a script file that can be used repeatedly. A script allows its contained commands to be executed as group; as a program; as a command.

Bash (short for "Bourne Again SHell") can operate within a terminal emulator, or text window, where users input commands to execute various tasks. A CLI is made possible... The format string is encoded as a template language consisting of verbatim text and format specifiers that each specify how to serialize a value. As the format string is processed left-to-right, a subsequent value is used for each format specifier found. A format specifier starts with a % character and has one or more following characters that specify how to serialize a value. It is designed as a 100% free alternative for the Bourne shell, `sh`, and other proprietary Unix shells.

Perl also be used for one-off scripts on the command line. Though Perl is not officially an acronym, there are various backronyms in use, including "Practical Extraction and Reporting Language".
