Divine providence and liberty. Miracles and even retribution generally fall in the latter category. A distinction is usually made between "general providence", which refers to God's continuous upholding of the existence and natural order of the universe, and "special providence", which refers to God's extraordinary intervention in the life of people. The term Divine Providence (usually capitalized) is also used as a title of God. As stated above, Reformed theology relates these terms to predestination.
