Cicero was educated in Rome and in Greece. He is considered one of Rome's greatest orators and prose stylists and the innovator of what became known as "Ciceronian rhetoric". During his consulship Marcus Tullius Cicero (SIS-ə-roh; Latin: ['ma:rkʊs 'tʊli]. Though he was an accomplished orator and successful lawyer, Cicero believed his political career was his most important achievement. His extensive writings include treatises on rhetoric, philosophy and politics. He came from a wealthy municipal family of the Roman equestrian order, and served as consul in 63 BC.

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
