It was described as "a reimplementation of the System V shell [with] most features of that shell, plus some additions". Python using CPython `Linux From Scratch` is a way to install a working Linux system by building all components of it manually. This is, naturally, a longer process than installing a pre-compiled Linux distribution. According to the `Linux From Scratch` site, the advantages to this method are a compact, flexible and secure system and a greater understanding of the internal workings of the Linux-based operating systems.

Optionally, there can be a special FISH server program (called start\_fish\_server) on the server, which executes FISH commands instead of Unix shell and thus speeds up operations. f6d6381cfc When a Linux system is powered up or reset, its processor will execute a specific firmware/program for system initialization, such as the power-on self-test, invoking the reset vector to start a program at a known address in flash/ROM (in embedded Linux devices), then load the bootloader into RAM for later execution. In IBM PC-compatible personal computers (PCs), this firmware/program is either a BIOS or a UEFI monitor, and is stored in the mainboard. In embedded Linux systems, this firmware/program is called boot ROM.
