Design infringement The definition of a design infringement differs in each jurisdiction but typically encompasses the purported use and make of the design, as

well as if the design is imported or sold during registration. The infringement is of the visual appearance. The visual features protected are the shape, configuration, pattern or ornamentation. property right concerned with the visual appearance of articles which have commercial or industrial use. The visual form of the product is what is protected rather than the product itself. To understand if a person has infringed the monopoly of the registered design, the design is assessed under each jurisdiction's provisions. A design infringement is where a person infringes a registered design during the period of registration.
