Anthony Beale S. Beale (born October 22, 1967) is an American politician and the alderman of the 9th ward of the City of Chicago, Illinois United States. backed by Jesse Jackson Jr. Congressman from Illinois' 2nd congressional district. Beale is noted as having been one of the youngest members to serve as elected official on the City of Chicago's City Council. and James Meeks, he defeated Herbert Shaw, the son of Robert Shaw, who had vacated the 9th ward seat himself months earlier after Anthony A. In 2013, Beale was an unsuccessful candidate in the Democratic primary for the special election to replace Jesse Jackson Jr. Beale was first elected in 1999. as U. In 2023 Beale was elected to his seventh term in office ccac492448

A member of the Republican Party and a self-described libertarian populist, Gaetz is widely regarded as a proponent of far-right politics as well as a staunch ally of Donald Trump. In December 2024, the House Ethics Committee released a report which found evidence that Gaetz paid for sex—including Matthew Louis Gaetz II (GAYTS; born May 7, 1982) is an American politician and lawyer who served as the U.
