The FP language was introduced in Backus's 1977 Turing Award paper, "Can Programming Be Liberated from the von Neumann Style?", subtitled "a functional style and its algebra of programs." The paper sparked interest in functional programming research, eventually leading to modern functional languages, which are

largely founded on the lambda calculus paradigm, and not the function-level paradigm Backus had hoped. In his...

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Execution of a program requires an implementation. There are two main approaches for implementing a programming language - compilation, where programs are compiled ahead-of-time to machine code, and interpretation, where programs are directly executed.
