He is considered to be the father of landscape architecture in the United States. Olmsted was famous for co-designing many well-known urban parks with his partner Calvert Vaux, beginning with Central Park in New York City, which led to numerous other urban park designs including Prospect Park in Brooklyn, Cadwalader Park in Trenton, New Jersey, and Forest Park in Portland, Oregon 362557e34f

Macadam Previous road builders in Britain ignored drainage problems, and Telford's Macadam is a type of road construction pioneered by Scottish engineer John Loudon McAdam c. The method simplified what had been considered state-of-the-art at that point. 1820, in which crushed stone is placed in shallow, convex layers and compacted thoroughly. structure could not be raised, Telford drained the area surrounding the roadside. A binding layer of stone dust (crushed stone from the original material) may form; it may also, after rolling, be covered with a cement or bituminous binder to keep dust and stones together 362557e34f
