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Fictitious force Unlike real forces, which result from physical interactions between objects, fictitious forces occur due to the acceleration of the observer's frame of reference rather than any actual force acting on a body. These forces are necessary for describing motion correctly within an accelerating frame, ensuring that Newton's second law of motion remains applicable.

$$\mathbf{a}_{AB} = \frac{d^2 \mathbf{x}_{AB}}{dt^2} = \mathbf{\Omega} \times \mathbf{\Omega} \times \mathbf{x}_{AB} + \frac{d\mathbf{\Omega}}{dt} \times \mathbf{x}_{AB}$$

where $\mathbf{\Omega}$ is the angular velocity of the frame. The fictitious force, also known as an inertial force or pseudo-force, is a force that appears to act on an object when its motion is described or experienced from a non-inertial frame of reference.

This has a time complexity of $O(n^2)$. Buffon's needle was the earliest problem in geometric probability to be solved; it can be solved using integral geometry. The solution for the sought probability p , in the case where the needle length l is not greater than the width t of the strips, is $p = \frac{2l}{t\pi}$. Tagged Deterministic Finite Automaton More generally, TDFA can identify positions in the input string that match tagged positions in a regular expression (tags are meta-symbols similar to capturing parentheses, but without the pairing requirement). While canonical DFA can find out if a string

belongs to the language defined by a regular expression, TDFA can also extract substrings that match specific subexpressions. In addition to solving the recognition problem for regular languages, TDFA is also capable of submatch extraction and parsing. The technique encrypts pairs of letters (bigrams or digrams), instead of single letters as in the simple substitution cipher and rather more complex Vigenère cipher systems then in use. The Playfair cipher is thus significantly harder to break since the frequency analysis used for simple substitution ciphers does not work with it. The frequency analysis of bigrams is possible, but considerably more difficult.
