For the differential equivalent of this equation see Maxwell’s equations. A permanent magnet's magnetic field pulls on ferromagnetic materials such as iron, and attracts or repels other magnets. Magnetic fields surround magnetized materials, electric currents, and electric fields varying in time. In addition, a nonuniform magnetic field exerts minuscule forces on "nonmagnetic" materials by three other magnetic effects: paramagnetism, diamagnetism, and antiferromagnetism, although these forces are usually so small they can only be detected by laboratory equipment.
