Waterfall model The waterfall model is the process of performing the typical software development life cycle (SDLC) phases in sequential order. Compared to alternative SDLC methodologies, it is among the least iterative and flexible, as progress flows largely in one direction (like a waterfall) through the phases of conception, requirements analysis, design, construction, testing, deployment, and maintenance. Each phase is completed before the next is started, and the result of each phase drives subsequent phases. Rational unified process RUP is a specific implementation of the Unified Process. synchronized and verified constantly. RUP is not a single concrete prescriptive process, but rather an adaptable process framework, intended to be tailored by the development organizations and software project teams that will select the elements of the process that are appropriate for their needs.
