History of English Old English reflected the varied origins of the Anglo-Saxon kingdoms established in different parts of Britain. The Anglo-Saxons settled in the British Isles from the mid-5th century and came to dominate the bulk of southern Great Britain. Anglian dialects had a greater influence on Middle English. Their language originated as a group of Ingvaenonic languages which were spoken by the settlers in England and southern and eastern Scotland in the early Middle Ages, displacing the Celtic languages, and, possibly, British Latin, that had previously been dominant. The Late West Saxon dialect eventually became dominant.
