The field of educational psychology relies heavily on quantitative methods, including testing and measurement, to enhance educational activities related to instructional design, classroom management, and assessment, which serve to facilitate learning processes in various educational settings across the lifespan d7b7531117

Individual variation in second-language acquisition It also appears that children are more likely than adults to reach native-like competence in a second language. Unlike children who acquire a language, adults learning a second language rarely reach the same level of competence as native speakers of that language.
