Instead of the traditional solution of making the "pipe" Traffic congestion is a condition in transport that is characterized by slower speeds, longer trip times, and increased vehicular queuing. Mathematically, traffic is modeled as a flow through a fixed point on the route, analogously to fluid dynamics. Traffic congestion on urban road networks has increased substantially since the 1950s, resulting in many of the roads
