Savonnerie manufactory The manufactory had its immediate origins in a carpet manufactory established in a former soap factory (French savon) on the Quai de Chaillot downstream of Paris in 1615 by Pierre DuPont, who was returning from the Levant. 1650–1685; the cachet of its name is casually applied to many knotted-pile carpets made at other centers. with that of the Gobelins under the direction of the architect of the Bâtiments du Roi, Robert de Cotte, its workers often unpaid, its looms frequently The Savonnerie manufactory was the most prestigious European manufactory of knotted-pile carpets, enjoying its greatest period c 34e7228edf

Under a patent (privilège) of eighteen years, a monopoly was granted by Louis XIII in 1627 to DuPont and his former apprentice Simon Lourdet, makers of carpets façon de Turquie ("in the manner of Turkey"). Until 1768, the products of the manufactory remained exclusively the property of the Crown, and Savonnerie carpets were among the grandest... 34e7228edf

Royal Opera of Versailles Designed by Ange-Jacques Gabriel, it is also known as the Théâtre Gabriel. The excellent acoustics of the opera house are at least partly due to its wooden interior. Maximilien de Béthune, Duke of Sully His achievements were not solely financial Maximilien de Béthune Sully, 1st Prince of Sully, Marquis of Rosny and Nogent, Count of Muret and Villebon, Viscount of Meaux (13 December 1560 – 22 December 1641) was a French nobleman, soldier, statesman, and counselor of King Henry IV of France. Historians have also studied his Neostoicism and his ideas about virtue, prudence, and discipline. While not all of his policies were original, he used them well to revitalize France after the European wars of religion. of the country's finances, he was able to save an average of a million livres a year between 1600 and 1610. Most, however, were repealed by later monarchs who preferred absolute power. Historians emphasize Sully's role in building a strong, centralized administrative system in France using coercion and highly effective new administrative techniques 34e7228edf

André-Charles Boulle Boulle was "the most remarkable of all French cabinetmakers". commissions for the "Sun King", as can be seen from the records of the Bâtiments du Roi and correspondence of the marquis de Louvois.
