The inter-relationships among the attributes are The attribute hierarchy method (AHM), is a cognitively based psychometric procedure developed by Jacqueline Leighton, Mark Gierl, and Steve Hunka at the Centre for Research in Applied Measurement and Evaluation (CRAME) at the University of Alberta. This cognitive diagnostic feedback has the potential to guide instructors, parents and students. A cognitive diagnostic assessment (CDA), is designed to measure specific knowledge states and cognitive processing skills in a given domain. The AHM is one form of cognitive diagnostic assessment that aims to integrate cognitive psychology with educational measurement for the purposes of enhancing instruction and student learning. The results of a CDA yield a profile of

scores with detailed information about a student's cognitive strengths and weaknesses

Inverse problem Inverse problems are some of the most important mathematical problems in science and mathematics because they tell An inverse problem in science is the process of calculating from a set of observations the causal factors that produced them: for example, calculating an image in X-ray computed tomography, source reconstruction in acoustics, or calculating the density of the Earth from measurements of its gravity field. It is the inverse of a forward problem, which starts with the causes and then calculates the effects. It is called an inverse problem because it starts with the effects and then calculates the causes. causes and then calculates the effects

P versus NP problem NP-complete problems are problems that any other NP problem is reducible to in polynomial time and whose solution The P versus NP problem is a major unsolved problem in theoretical computer science. concept of NP-completeness is very useful. Informally, it asks whether every problem whose solution can be quickly verified can also be quickly solved

The multiple-choice test sections of the ACT (all except the optional writing test) are individually scored on a scale of 1–36. In addition, a composite score consisting of the rounded whole number average of the scores for English, reading, and math is provided. The NCTM employed a consensus process that involved classroom teachers, mathematicians, and educational researchers. Here, "quickly" means an algorithm exists that solves the task and runs in polynomial time (as opposed to, say, exponential time), meaning the task completion time is bounded above by a polynomial function on the size of the input to the algorithm. The general class of questions that some algorithm can answer in polynomial time is "P" or "class P". For some questions, there is no known way to find an answer quickly, but if provided with an answer, it can be verified quickly. The class of questions where an answer can be verified in polynomial time is "NP", standing for "nondeterministic polynomial time...
