Four major factors favor A transmission medium is a system or substance that can mediate the propagation of signals for the purposes of telecommunication. Vacuum or air constitutes a good transmission medium for electromagnetic waves such as light and radio waves. commonly used transmission medium for long-distance communications, is a thin strand of glass that guides light along its length. While a material substance is not required for electromagnetic waves to propagate, such waves are usually affected by the transmission medium they pass through, for instance, by absorption or reflection or refraction at the interfaces between media. For example, data can modulate sound, and a transmission medium for sounds may be air, but solids and liquids may also act as the transmission medium 182de9ea71
