Chapter 20 of the Book of Exodus begins: 33f073193d The hymn begins with the words that the angels sang when announcing the birth of Christ to shepherds in Luke 2:14: Douay-Rheims (in Latin). Other verses were added very early, forming a doxology. 33f073193d
