Cherry Springs State Park Cherry Springs, named for a large stand of Black Cherry trees in the park, is atop the dissected Allegheny Plateau at an elevation of 2,300 feet (701 m). chipmunks, minks, raccoons, porcupines, groundhogs, and the occasional bobcat, as well as frogs, beetles, and moths. The park is near the borough of Benton on Pennsylvania Route 118 and Pennsylvania Route 487, and is in five townships: Sugarloaf in Columbia County, Fairmount and Ross in Luzerne County, and Colley and Davidson in Sullivan County. In addition to Ricketts Glen State Park is a Pennsylvania state park on 13,193 acres (5,280 ha) in Columbia, Luzerne, and Sullivan counties in Pennsylvania in the United States. Cooper's hawk When large quadrupeds walk under the nest Cooper's hawk (*Astur cooperii*) is a medium-sized hawk native to the North American continent and found from southern Canada to Mexico. It is easily confused with the smaller but similar sharp-shinned hawk. The birds found east of the Mississippi River tend to be larger on average than the birds found to the west.
