Placemaking " Jan Gehl has said "First life, then spaces, then buildings – the other way around never Placemaking is a multi-faceted approach to the planning, design and management of public spaces. are good at putting up buildings but we are bad at making places. Placemaking is both a process and a philosophy that makes use of urban design principles. It can be either official and government led, or community driven grassroots tactical urbanism, such as extending sidewalks with chalk, paint, and planters, or open streets events such as Bogotá, Colombia's Ciclovía. Placemaking capitalizes on a local community's assets, inspiration, and potential, with the intention of creating public spaces that improve urban vitality and promote people's health, happiness, and well-being. It is political due to the nature of place identity. Good placemaking makes use of underutilized space to enhance the urban experience at the pedestrian scale to build habits of locals b8fa2293b3
