Trolling motor gasoline-powered outboard used in trolling, if it is not the vessel's primary source of propulsion, may also be referred to as a trolling motor. Trolling motors are often lifted from the water to reduce drag when the boat's primary engine is in operation. The main function of trolling motors was once to keep the boat running at a consistent, low speed suitable for trolling, but that function has been augmented by GPS-tracking trolling motors that function as "virtual anchors" to automatically maintain a boat's position relative to a desired location, such as a favorite fishing spot. Its outboard motor has a long snorkel so the Subskimmer can run on motor just submerged to try to avoid detection The Subskimmer is a diver propulsion vehicle which is a form of rigid inflatable boat (RIB) with an outboard petrol (gasoline) engine. The batteries, being heavy, are in a thick tube along its keel. Thus it transforms between a fast light surface boat and a submerged diver propulsion vehicle. are in a thick tube along its keel.
