Bards use their artistic talents to induce magical effects. The bard class is versatile, capable of combat and of magic (divine magic in earlier editions, arcane magic in later editions). Listed inspirations for bards include Taliesin, Homer, Will Scarlet, and Alan-a-Dale. Criticism of the Book of Abraham Many non-LDS Egyptologists, beginning in the mid-19th century, have criticized Joseph Smith's translation and explanations of the facsimiles, unanimously concluding that his interpretations are inaccurate. The Book of Abraham contains a creation story similar to Genesis chapters 1 and 2. According to Smith, the book was "a translation of some ancient records. Since its printing, the Book of Abraham has been a source of controversy. They have also asserted that missing portions of two of the facsimiles were reconstructed incorrectly by Smith. purporting to be the writings of Abraham, while he was in Egypt, called the Book of Abraham, written by his own hand, upon papyrus". The Book of The Book of Abraham is a work produced sometime between 1835 and 1842 by the Latter Day Saints (LDS) movement founder Joseph Smith that he said was based on Egyptian papyri purchased from a traveling mummy exhibition. 9th century BC—well after the purported time of Abraham. This claim is universally rejected by modern scholars, most of whom believe de León, also an infamous forger of Geonic material, wrote the book himself between 1280 and 1286. Some scholars argue that the Zohar is the work of multiple medieval authors and/or contains a small amount of genuinely antique novel material. Later additions to the Zohar, including Tiqqune hazZohar and Ra'ya Meheimna, were composed by a 14th century imitator. 822aa7df8e
