Factor analysis Factor analysis searches for such joint variations in response to unobserved latent variables. For example, it is possible that variations in six observed variables mainly reflect the variations in two unobserved (underlying) variables. have different measured aptitudes in astronomy because individual aptitudes differ from average aptitudes (predicted above) and because of measurement Factor analysis is a statistical method used to describe variability among observed, correlated variables in terms of a potentially lower number of unobserved variables called factors. The observed variables are modelled as linear combinations of the potential factors plus "error" terms, hence factor analysis can be thought of as a special case of errors-in-variables models 88fe7ab5ab

Modern cognitive tests originated through the work of James McKeen Cattell who coined the term "mental tests". They followed Francis Galton's development of physical and physiological tests. For example, Galton measured strength of grip and height and weight. He established an "Anthropometric Laboratory" in the 1880s where patrons paid to have

physical and physiological attributes measured... Tests vary in style, rigor and requirements. There is no general consensus or invariable standard for test formats and difficulty. Often, the format and difficulty of the test is dependent upon the educational philosophy of the instructor, subject matter, class size, policy of the educational institution, and requirements of accreditation or governing bodies. Inductive reasoning aptitude: Also known as abstract reasoning tests and diagrammatic
Cognitive tests are assessments of the cognitive capabilities of humans and other animals. Such testing is used in psychology and psychometrics, as well as other fields studying human and animal intelligence. Tests administered to humans include various forms of IQ tests; those administered to animals include the mirror test (a test of visual self-awareness) and the T maze test (which tests learning ability)
