More than half of all Europeans claim to speak at least one language other than their mother tongue, but many read and write in one language. Being multilingual is advantageous for people wanting to participate in trade, globalization and cultural openness. People who speak several languages are also called polyglots. the notion that monolingual solutions are essential to the realization of functional bilingualism, with multilingual solutions ultimately leading to monolingualism Multilingualism is the use of more than one language, either by an individual speaker or by a group of speakers d52a361a10

Reading comprehension Reading comprehension relies on two abilities that are connected Reading comprehension is the ability to process written text, understand its meaning, and to integrate with what the reader already knows. process written text, understand its meaning, and to integrate with what the reader already knows. Reading comprehension occurs on a gradient or spectrum, rather than being yes/no (all-or-nothing). The opposite of reading comprehension is called functional illiteracy. Reading comprehension is beyond basic literacy alone, which is the ability to decipher characters and words at all. Reading comprehension relies on two abilities that are connected to each other: word reading and language comprehension. Comprehension specifically is a "creative, multifaceted process" that is dependent upon four language skills: phonology, syntax, semantics, and pragmatics. In education it is measured in standardized tests that report which percentile a reader's ability falls d52a361a10

Literacy 17 July 2017 Literacy is the ability to read and write, while illiteracy refers to an inability to read and write. Some researchers suggest that the study of "literacy" as a concept can be divided into two periods: the period before 1950, when literacy was understood solely as alphabetical literacy (word and letter recognition); and the period after 1950, when literacy slowly began to be considered as a wider concept and process, including the social and cultural aspects of reading, writing, and functional literacy.
