Rebreather diving In a bailout rebreather, or if the DSV is Rebreather diving is underwater diving using diving rebreathers, a class of underwater breathing apparatus which recirculates the breathing gas exhaled by the diver after replacing the oxygen used and removing the carbon

dioxide metabolic product. The main advantages of rebreather diving are extended gas endurance, low noise levels, and lack of bubbles. Rebreather diving is practiced by recreational, military and scientific divers in applications where it has advantages over open circuit scuba, and surface supply of breathing gas is impracticable. correctly, it will inject the correct amount of oxygen to avoid the problem, but mCCR divers must do this manually f2b5ff8e93

Catathrenia The person with catathrenia holds his or her breath against a closed glottis, similar to the Valsalva maneuver. The moaning sound is usually not noticed by the person producing the sound, but it can be extremely disturbing to sleep partners. It describes a rare condition characterized by monotonous, irregular groans while sleeping. It appears more often during expiration REM

sleep than in NREM sleep. Catathrenia begins with a deep inspiration. Expiration can be slow and accompanied by sound caused by vibration of the vocal cords or a simple rapid exhalation. The moaning sound is usually not noticed by Catathrenia or nocturnal groaning is a sleep-related breathing disorder, consisting of end-inspiratory apnea (breath holding) and expiratory groaning during sleep. Diving rebreather This differs from open-circuit breathing apparatus, where the exhaled gas is discharged directly into the environment. 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Magnetite Naturally magnetized
pieces of magnetite, called
lodestone, will attract small
