The Chronicles of Narnia: Prince Caspian On the performances, he felt "the four kids overall have The Chronicles of Narnia: Prince Caspian is a 2008 high fantasy film produced by Walt Disney Pictures and Walden Media, and directed by Andrew Adamson. The screenplay, co-written by Adamson, Christopher Markus and Stephen McFeely, is based on the 1951 novel Prince Caspian, the second published and fourth chronological story in the children's book series The Chronicles of Narnia by C. S. Lewis. The film was praised for its improved special effects, the "timeless" locations and production design. It is the sequel to The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe (2005), it is the second installment in The Chronicles of Narnia film series.

Björk produced Post herself with co-producers including Nellee Hooper, 808 State's Graham Massey, and former Massive Attack member Tricky. She wrote most of the songs after moving to London and intended the album to reflect her new life in the city.
